Calangute Beach

Fort Aguada

Fort Aguada, a 1612 Portuguese fort, guards the Mandovi River with a lighthouse and spring. Its hilltop offers sweeping Arabian Sea views, perfect for sunset photos. This historic site blends colonial past with scenic allure.

Bom Jesus Basilica

The Bom Jesus Basilica, a UNESCO site from 1605, showcases Baroque beauty and houses St. Francis Xavier's tomb. Its red stone facade and gilded altars draw pilgrims, especially during the decennial exposition, highlighting Goa's Christian legacy.



Manguesh Temple

The Manguesh Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, blends Hindu and Portuguese styles with a seven-story lamp tower. Its Shiva lingam and Maha Shivaratri festivities amid greenery offer a serene dive into Goa's spiritual diversity.

Baga Beach

Baga Beach is Goa's high-energy hub, with water sports like windsurfing and dolphin tours, plus nightlife at beach clubs. Restaurants serve seafood and global fare, making it a top pick for fun and revelry.

Dona Paula View Point
