## **Hadimba Temple**

The Hadimba Temple, nestled in a cedar forest, is an ancient wooden shrine from 1553 dedicated to Hadimba Devi of Mahabharata fame. Its rugged terrain and thrilling altitude make it a stunning, adrenaline-filled escape for nature and adventure enthusiasts.
