#### **Chamundi Hills**

Chamundi Hills, at 1,000 meters, host the Chamundeshwari Temple, linked to Mysore's namesake demon. With 1,000 steps, a giant Nandi statue, and city views, it's a spiritual and scenic trek for devotees and explorers.

## Maharaja Palace

The Maharaja Palace, built in 1912, dazzles with Indo-Saracenic design, stained glass, and ornate halls like the Durbar and Kalyana Mantapa. Lit up on Sundays, it's a regal marvel of Mysore's royal heritage.

#### Mysore Zoo

Mysore Zoo, from 1892, spans 157 acres with over 1,500 animals, including white tigers and gorillas. Its conservation efforts and lush setting make it a top family and wildlife destination.

#### **Brindavan Garden**

Brindavan Garden, near the Krishnarajasagara Dam, boasts terraced lawns, vibrant blooms, and a musical fountain show at dusk. Boat rides enhance this symmetrical, picturesque retreat.

#### Sri Rangapatnam

Sri Rangapatnam, an island town, was Tipu Sultan's capital, featuring the Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple, fort ruins, and Gumbaz mausoleum. It's a historic dive into Mysore's royal and wartime past.

## **Tippu Palace**

Tippu Palace, or Dariya Daulat Bagh, is Tipu Sultan's 1784 summer home with teakwood and battle murals. Now a museum, its gardens and artifacts showcase his legacy in Sri Rangapatnam.

### **Nandi Hills**

Nandi Hills, near Bangalore, offers sunrise views, trekking, and temples like Yoga Nandeeshwara at 1,478 meters. With Tipu's Drop and a cool climate, it's a scenic adventure spot.
