### DAY 1: HANOI ARRIVAL - HALF DAY CITY TOUR ( - ) PRIVATE TOUR

Welcome to Hanoi – Vietnam!

Upon arrival at the International airport, you will be met by our Driver and transfer to the hotel for check-in.

The remaining time will be leisure on your own.

Afternoon: meet our guide and transfer to visit: Ho Chi Minh complex, including **Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum** – the final resting place of Vietnamese great father or Uncle Ho, President Ho Chi Minh's stilt house- where he lived on and off from 1958 to 1969. The next place to move to is **One Pillar Pagoda** – a group of structures consisting of a pagoda and a tower built in the middle of a square lake.

Back to downtown for refreshment by Hoan Kiem Lake, visit Hoan Kiem Lake (Restored Sword Lake)



with the Old Quarter, also known as the 36 streets, this bustling area of narrow streets is home to literally thousands of small businesses and shopkeepers. It's a great place to explore with plenty of photo opportunities. We will also have a chance to check in at the Hanoi Train Street - one of the most renowned tourist destinations in the capital. It is a tiny, winding street tucked away in one of Hanoi's back streets, surrounded by tightly clustered, tall, narrow houses. The train travels by the backyards of these families a couple times each day

Standard check-in time is 14:00 (or 15:00 at some hotels). Early check-in is subject to hotel availability.

#### DAY 2: HANOI - HALONG BAY (B/L/D) SHUTTLE BUS - SHARING CRUISE

Departing Hanoi for HaLong Bay, the drive is approximately three hours. Upon arrival at Ha Long, we will board our boat for a delicious seafood lunch while our boat is cruising around hundreds of wonderful limestone formations arising from emerald green water. After lunch we have the chance to explore one of the wonderful limestone caves dotted around the bay. Continue cruising to a secluded spot for swimming and sunbathing before dinner. Enjoy another seafood feast for dinner. Overnight on the boat.

# DAY 3: HALONG BAY – HANOI - FLY TO DANANG (B/BR) SHUTTLE BUS HALONG - PRIVATE AIRPORT CAR

Enjoy a relaxing morning and sunbath in Halong Bay after breakfast. Brunch is served on board around 11:30 AM on the way back to Hanoi. You **arrive in Hanoi between 3:00 and 3:30 PM**, with free time before catching your flight to Da Nang.

Then transfer to the airport (without a guide) for your flight to Da Nang. Upon your arrival, you will be escorted to your hotel for some rest. The remaining time will be leisure on your own. Overnight in Da Nang

#### DAY 4: BANA HILL - GOLDGEN BRIDGE (B/L) GROUP TOUR

8.00AM Your day begins with a convenient hotel pickup, followed by a stunning ride to **Ba Na Hills** via a cable car. Take an incredible journey on Southeast Asia's latest cable car, gazing at the wonderful scenery of Da Nang's coastline.

Once at the top, you can view the renowned Golden Bridge, stroll through the beautiful **Le Jardin D'amour gardens, and explore the serene Linh Ung Pagoda.** 

Then take another cable car ride to the **French Village**, where you'll find a charming European ambiance. Hear street music, see artistic sculptures, and watch a colorful carnival performance. Savor a buffet lunch, then take the Lava Train ride to witness new attractions like the Helios Waterfall and the Moon Kingdom.

Don't miss out on the fun at **Fantasy Park**, which has plenty of diverse rides and attractions. Your day ends with a cable car ride back and a relaxing minivan drive to your hotel around 17.00PM

- + Entry to key attractions, including the Golden Bridge, French Village, Le Jardin d'Amour gardens, Linh Ung Pagoda, and most of the Fantasy Park (around 105 free games)

#### DAY 5: FLY TO HO CHI MINH - HALF DAY CITY TOUR ( B ) PRIVATE TOUR

After breakfast, free and easy for your leisure, then transfer to the airport (without guide) for your flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon your arrival, you will be escorted to your hotel for some rest.

In the afternoon, your exploration of the city begins with a visit to the **Reunification Palace**, once the residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam until the historic reunification on April 30th, 1975. Your journey continues to the **Notre-Dame Cathedral**, a stunning architectural landmark built by French colonists between 1863 and 1880, originally known as l'Eglise de Saïgon. Nearby, you'll discover the **Saigon Central Post Office**, renowned for its remarkable fusion of neo-classical European architecture and traditional Asian design elements, making it a true architectural gem. The tour also includes a stop at the **Mariamman Hindu Temple**, a captivating site not only for its vibrant South Indian style but also for the spiritual story of Mariamman, believed to bring happiness and prosperity to the local community. Finally, wrap up your afternoon by visiting **Ben Thanh Market**, a bustling icon of Saigon offering a wide array of local foods, handicrafts, clothing, and souvenirs. With its energetic atmosphere and friendly vendors, Ben Thanh promises an authentic cultural experience that no visitor to Ho Chi Minh City should miss.

#### DAY 6: CU CHI TUNNEL (B) GROUP TOUR

7.30AM Depart from your hotel. The trip to **Cu Chi** will take approximately one and a half hours bus driving. Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have some short introduction followed by an introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of the war time. Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems which included the specially constructed living areas with kitchens, bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are also many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purposes during the war. Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla's food during the war) will be served. Break time for relaxing or time for those who want to try the real shooting gun (on your own expense). Return to Saigon.
